

The 2012 Black History Quiz Bowl Overwhelming Success:

This year, like in previous ones, the 2012 Lucy Craft Laney Museum of Black History annual quiz bowl was an overwhelming success.

The purpose of the competition is to test the recall of student's grades 7-12 in the areas of Augusta History, Georgia History, current affairs, and African-American History.

Students are asked toss-up questions worth ten points. Bonus questions are then given to the team that answers the toss-ups correctly.

Our teams this year consisted of Delta Academy, sponsored by the Augusta Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., the Hephzibah High School Black History Club, Richmond County Communities in Schools, and Old Storm Branch Baptist Church.

Although the competition was stiff, Old Storm Branch emerged victorious this year. All participants received a certificate of participation with Communities in Schools receiving silver medallions for second place and Old Storm Branch receiving gold medallions and 10 dollar gift cards to Barnes & Noble for their first place finish.

In addition, Charles Garrett, captain of the Storm Branch team, received an additional 10 dollar gift card for answering the most toss-up questions correctly.
